Notice of Proposed Property Tax Increase for Champaign County Government

1. A public hearing to approve a proposed property tax levy increase for Champaign County for 2006 will be held on Thursday, October 19, 2006 at 6:30pm, Lyle Shields Meeting Room, Brookens Administrative Center, 1776 East Washington, Urbana, IL.

2. The corporate and special purpose property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$20,339,589.72.

The proposed corporate and special purpose property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$21,661,137. This represents a 6.52% increase over the previous year.

3. The property taxes extended for debt service for 2005 were \$1,606,160.49.

The estimated property taxes to be levied for debt service for 2006 are \$1,596,672. This represents a 0.59% decrease in the levy over the previous year.

4. The total property taxes extended or abated for 2005 were \$21,945,750.21.

The estimated total property taxes to be levied for 2006 are \$23,257,809. This represents a 5.98% increase over the previous year.
