The Champaign County Racial Justice Task Force seeks to address causes and impact of racial disparities in the jail population and in the criminal justice system more broadly. It will report findings and a list of recommendations to the County Board and community. It is committed to working with all members of the public.

#### **Community forums**

- 2 events held- one at the Church of Living God in Champaign and the other at the IMC in Urbana
- Total participation = approximately 75 people
- Small group format with questions related to personal experiences and recommendations for change
- Feedback for recommendations was organized based on topic and there was a word count analysis completed.
- Personal stories- highlights from stories include:
  - Experiences of "driving while black"
  - Lack of diversity on juries/in court proceedings
  - Mistreatment of kids & parents in the school environment that is very different than white families
- Highest word counts include:

- Most discussed topics include:
  - Police practices
