### ORDINANCE NO. 992 ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE FOR A ZONING MAP AMENDMENT ON CERTAIN PROPERTY

#### 869-AM-17

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing, made a formal recommendation for approval, and forwarded to this Board Zoning Case 869-AM-17;

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Board believes it is for the best interests of the County and for the public good and welfare to amend the Champaign County Zoning Ordinance in a manner hereinafter provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Champaign County Board, Champaign County, Illinois, as follows:

1. That Resolution No. 971, *The Zoning Ordinance of the County of Champaign, Illinois*, be amended by reclassifying:

Part A: Change the zoning district designation from the R-1 Single Family Residence Zoning District to the R-5 Manufactured Home Park Zoning District for the eastern 175 feet of the subject property described as Tract 1 and Tract 2 in the attached Exhibit A; and

Part B: Change the zoning district designation from the B-2 Neighborhood Business Zoning District to the R-5 Manufactured Home Park Zoning District for the western (approximately) 160 feet of the subject property described as Tract 1 in the attached Exhibit A.

2. That the boundary lines of the Zoning Map be changed in accordance with the provisions hereof.

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEMOLITION OF DANGEROUS BUILDING AND CLEANUP OF GARBAGE AND DEBRIS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF CHAMPAIGN COUNTY AT 2218 EAST UNIVERSITY AVENUE, URBANA

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Board may provide for the removal of garbage and debris from property in the unincorporated areas of Champaign County if the owner of the property refuses or neglects to remove the garbage and debris, and may then obtain a lien on the property for the costs of garbage and debris removal (55 ILCS 5/5-1118); and

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Board may demolish, repair, or enclose, or cause the demolition, repair, or enclosure of dangerous and unsafe buildings within the territory of Champaign County, but outside the territory of any municipality, and may remove or cause the removal of garbage, debris, and other hazardous, noxious or unhealthy substances or materials from those buildings, and may then obtain a lien on the property for the costs of demolition, repair, enclosure, and garbage and debris removal (55 ILCS 515-1 121(a)); and

WHEREAS, the property located at 2218 East University Avenue, Urbana, Illinois, with Permanent Index Number 30-21-10-351-016 ("subject property") is in an unincorporated area of Champaign County; and

WHEREAS, the subject property contains garbage and debris; and

WHEREAS, the subject property contains one or more dangerous and unsafe buildings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Champaign County, as follows:

- 1. The Champaign County State's Attorney is hereby authorized, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1118, to obtain approval from the Champaign County Circuit Court to remove garbage and debris from the subject property;
- 2. The Champaign County State's Attorney is hereby authorized, pursuant to 55 ILCS 5/5-1121(a), to obtain approval from the Champaign County Circuit Court to cause the demolition, repair, or enclosure of any dangerous and unsafe buildings located on the subject property and to cause the removal of garbage, debris, and other hazardous, noxious or unhealthy substances or materials from those buildings.

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that based on the representations in the attached Petition, it is required pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501 to provide the requested aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Champaign County as follows:

- 1. The County Board hereby appropriates from the County Bridge Fund a sufficient sum to meet 50% of the cost of engineering and 10% of the cost of construction to replace the aforesaid the structure.
- 2. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for said improvement.
- 3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, either by the letting of a contract or by the County Highway Department doing the work.
- 4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his or her approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvement, and shall show the division of cost between the County and the Newcomb Road District.
- 5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Newcomb</u> Road District.
  - 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

### **PETITION**

Petitioner, <u>Brett Cox</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the Newcomb Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>bridge</u> located <u>between Sections 25 and 26</u>, which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that the bridge be <u>replaced</u>; and
- 4. The cost of <u>replacing</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$150,000, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Newcomb</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the Newcomb Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The Newcomb Road District is prepared to pay 10% of the construction cost and 50% of the engineering costs associated with the <u>replacement</u> of said structure.

RE: A Proposed Change in the County Board Rules

Per Rule 8.1 of Resolution 9162, Written notice of any proposed change(s) to these Rules is to be presented to the Policy. Personnel, and Appointments Committee of the Whole at least fourteen (14) days prior to any consideration of such changes, I will be proposing the following change in the County Board Rules:

Removal of Rule 16.E.1.j. Receives and considers for recommendation to the County Board all grant applications and or awards for Champaign County offices and agencies.

Currently, all grant applications and awards are routed through the Finance Committee. Removal of this rule allows the grants to go through the committees, which have the more vested interest in the grants. For example, utility efficiency grants would go through Facilities, and justice-oriented grants would go through Justice and Social Services. This rule was added a few years ago and one of its effects was to remove many of the grants that normally went through Justice and Social Services. The non-finance committees can readily review grant applications and accept the awards.

#### RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUPPORT FOR THE POSITION OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, the voters of the County of Champaign adopted by referendum the County Executive form of government; and

WHEREAS, the Champaign County Board recognizes that the effective, efficient and reliable execution of the administrative functions of the County government requires a qualified, professional municipal manager accountable to the County through an employment relationship,

Re: AFSCME Head Start Contract Ratification

#### **ISSUE**

The AFSCME Head Start bargaining unit has ratified a new agreement with the County. Staff recommends approval of the agreement by the County board.

#### **NARRATIVE**

The AFSCME Head Start contract expired on February 28, 2017, with negotiations for a successor agreement beginning in December 2016 and concluding recently with a favorable ratification vote by the bargaining unit members. The new contract is a three-year agreement beginning March 1, 2017 and terminating on February 29, 2020. The contract covers 114 Head Start positions.

The year one contract includes an across-the-board base wage increase of 2% retroactive to March 1, 2017; movement to newly established wage rates on September 1, 2017; and a one-time career recognition award of \$500 for all staff excluding bus drivers and preschool teachers. (The bus drivers and preschool teachers will receive the highest wage rate increases of all position classifications effective September 1, 2017).

Effective March 1, 2018, employees who have completed 10 to 15 years of Head Start service will receive a one-time career recognition award of \$350. Employees who have completed 16 or more years of Head Start service will receive a one-time career recognition award of \$500. All bargaining unit employees will receive a permanent 1% increase to their base wage rates effective March 1, 2018 or the federal COLA, whichever is higher.

Effective March 1, 2019, employees who have completed 10 or more years of Head Start service will receive a one-time career recognition award of \$500. All bargaining unit employees will receive a permanent 1% increase to their base wage rates effective March 1, 2019 or the federal COLA, whichever is higher.

Health insurance contributions rates are \$50 per month in year one (January 2017), \$55 per month in year two (January 2018), and \$60 per month in year three (January 2019).

The new contract proposal will require staffing reconfigurations in order to meet federal and state performance, budgetary, and operational standards. The newly established wage rates are in response to a highly competitive labor market for qualified teaching and bus driver positions. Our strategy is to continue to offer professional development and educational advancement opportunities for existing staff in an effort to meet the continuing demand for qualified staff.

The new contact represents a mutually satisfactory agreement.

#### REQUESTED ACTION

The Champaign County board approves the proposed agreement between the County and the AFSCME Head Start bargaining unit for the term beginning March 1, 2017 through February 29, 2020.

#### **ISSUE HIGHLIGHTS**

- · County has entered negotiations on five FOP contracts, all having expired at the end of 2016;
- Agreements have been executed with two units: Corrections Sergeants; and Probation and Court Services;
- Court Security negotiations are scheduled; Corrections Officers are slated for interest arbitration;
- Tentative agreement has been reached with the Deputies and Deputy Sergeants

#### **NARRATIVE**

The County has entered negotiations with the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) for five collective bargaining agreements expiring at the end of 2016. These agreements cover employees in the Sheriff's Office and Probation and Court Services and include deputies and sergeants, corrections officers and sergeants, and court security personnel, probation and juvenile detention officers.

We reached tentative agreement with law enforcement deputies and sergeants and have been notified by FOP that the local unit has ratified the proposal. We therefore are presenting this contract to County Board for final approval.

In Illinois, certain bargaining units have rights to mandatory interest arbitration for impasse resolution. The FOP Law Enforcement unit is one of those. One of the compelling factors in negotiating contract economics is maintenance of wage levels comparable to those of the accepted market comparison counties. For the purposes of this negotiation, Champaign County and the Illinois FOP Labor Council use wage data from the Illinois counties of McLean, Peoria, Rock Island, and Sangamon. The statutory requirement of interest arbitration provides an irresistible upward pressure on wages. There have been proposals in the General Assembly to require arbitrators to evaluate the

financial capacity of governmental entities and whether they can afford to pay for a contract as primary considerations in their decision-making. However, to date none of these proposals has been successfully adopted.

The three-year proposal (January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019) is largely unchanged except for several economic adjustments. The net three-year cost of this contract is projected to be \$633,340.

In the table below, you will note two columns labeled "adjustment increase" and "effective increase." The FOP Law Enforcement contract contains a wage scale with step increases applied upon each employee's anniversary date. The impact of the across-the-board adjustments and the step adjustment is shown in the effective increase total. The wage scale, adopted many years ago in negotiations, is not a linear scale; in other words, it has variances in the percentage increase between steps. These percentages range from -0.37% to as much as 4.21%. Therefore, you will note that while the adjustment increases negotiated this term are less than the previous contract, the effective increases have significant variances, particularly noticeable in year two of the new contract. The bargaining unit has not expressed interest in changing the wage scale format.

- Investigators supplemental pay increase from \$750 to \$1200 per year.
- This unit has agreed to increased employee contributions for County-provided health insurance. Employee contributions will remain at 10% for the remainder of 2017, then increase to 12% in year two (contribution increase 20% YOY), and 14% in year three (contribution increase 16.7% YOY), with annual caps at \$83, \$100, and \$125 per month respectively.
- Maximum comp time accrual has been increased from 40 hours to 60 hours.
- To standardize ammunition and weapon types, new deputies with CCSO shall be issued an approved weapon to be used always when on duty.

We believe that the ratified proposal represents a mutually satisfactory result and is also in compliance with the economic authority granted by the Labor Committee. We therefore submit this proposal for your consideration and approval.

#### REQUESTED ACTION

The Champaign County Board approves the agreement by and between the Champaign County Board, Champaign County Sheriff and the Illinois F.O.P. Labor Council (Champaign County Law Enforcement Deputies and Sergeants) for the term of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019.

Re: Closed Session Minutes Review for Champaign County Board

Dear Mr. Weibel:

Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, a public body such as the Champaign County Board must review its closed session minutes at least semi-annually. The Board must then determine whether the need for confidentiality exists as to all or part of those minutes, or that the minutes or portions thereof no longer require confidential treatment, if so, the records would be available for public inspection. Therefore, the question is whether there is no longer a need to keep minutes closed in order to protect either the public interest or the privacy of an individual. Whichever conclusion that the Board draws must be then be reported in open session.

Please note that the Board may enter into closed session for the purpose of review of closed session minutes pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(21): Discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under the Act. Just as in open session, if the matter requires action by the Board, the matter must have been noticed on the posted agenda.

The County Board passed Resolution No. 7969, "Resolution Establishing Procedures for Semi-Annual Review of Closed Session Minutes by the Champaign County Board" on November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Under the parameters established by the full board in Resolution 7969, none of the minutes are ripe for review.
