WHEREAS, Lillian Moore, has paid \$12,359.04 for the full amount of taxes involved and a request for surrender of the tax sale certificate has been presented to the Finance Committee of the Whole at the same time it having been determined by the Finance Committee of the Whole and Agent for the County, that the County shall receive from \$6,866.97 as a return for its Certificate of Purchase. The County Clerk shall receive \$51.00 for cancellation of Certificate and to reimburse the revolving account for the charges advanced therefrom, Lillian Moore shall receive \$96.00 for overpayment; and the agent under his contact shall receive \$5,441.07 for his services.

RESOLUTION TO DESIGNATE THE OFFICE OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEYS APPELLATE PROSECUTOR AS AGENT

WHEREAS, The Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor was created to provide services to State's Attorneys in Judicial Districts containing less than 3,000,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, The powers and duties of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are defined and enumerated in the "State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's Act", 725 ILCS 210/1 et. seq., as amended; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois General Assembly appropriates monies for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, one-third from the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's County Fund and two-thirds from the General Revenue Fund, provided that such funding receives county approval and support from within the respective Judicial Districts eligible to apply; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall administer the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

WHEREAS, The Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor and the Illinois General Assembly have reviewed and approved a budget for Fiscal Year 2018, which funds will provide for the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Champaign County Board, in regular session, this 18th day of January, 2018 does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorneys of this county in the appeal of all cases, when requested to do so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act. Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the State's Attorney's duties under the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act, including negotiations thereunder, as well as in the trial and appeal of tax objections; and

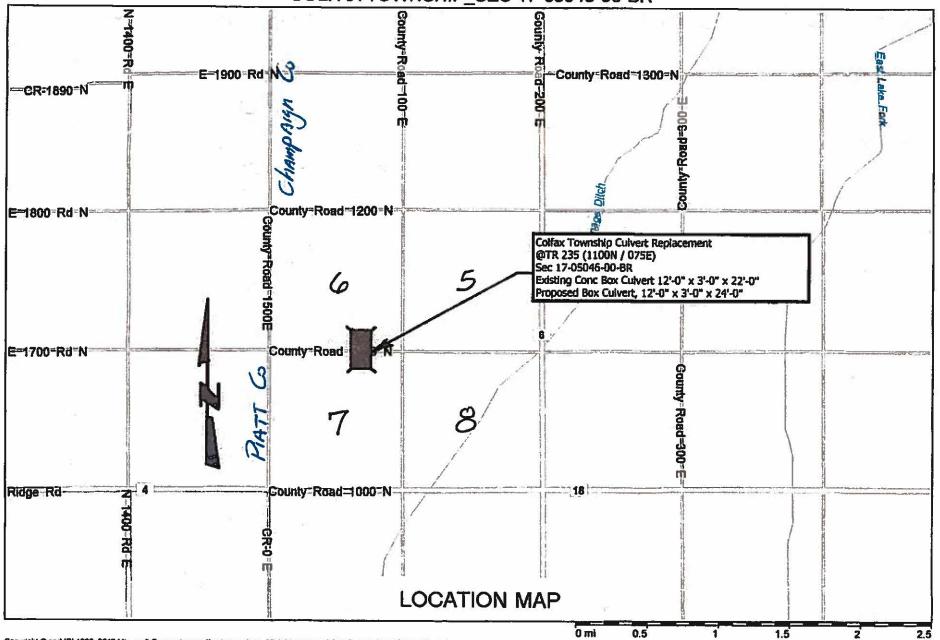

Ratification of Collective Bargaining Agreement-FOP Court Security

The County has concluded negotiations with the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) for five collective bargaining agreements expiring at the end of 2016. These agreements cover employees in the Sheriff's Office and Probation and Court Services and include deputies and sergeants, corrections officers and sergeants, court security personnel, and probation and juvenile detention officers. The term of the contracts is January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2019. All units have agreed to increased employee contributions for County-provided health insurance in FY2018 and FY2019.

An agreement with the Court Security Officers has been reached and the local unit has ratified the proposal. For the purposes of this negotiation, Champaign County and the Illinois FOP Labor Council use wage data from the Illinois counties of Peoria and Sangamon. Other comparable counties use road deputies to perform court security functions; therefore those counties are not used for comparison. The three-year proposal (January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019) is largely unchanged except for several economic adjustments. The net three-year cost of this contract is projected to be \$111,765. The ratified proposal is in compliance with the economic authority granted by the Labor Committee.

The Court Security contract contains a wage scale with step increases applied upon each employee's anniversary date. The impact of the across-the-board adjustments and step adjustments is shown in the table below as the effective increase total.

- This unit has agreed to increased employee contributions for County-provided health insurance. Employee contributions will remain at 10% for 2017, then increase to 12% in 2018 (contribution increase 20% YOY), and 14% in 2019 (contribution increase 16.7% YOY), with annual caps at \$83, \$100, and \$125 per month respectively.
- Effective January 1, 2019, step 23 will be implemented and step 2 will be eliminated.
- To standardize ammunition and weapon types, new officers shall be issued an approved weapon to be used always when on duty.
- Maximum comp time accrual has been increased from 40 hours to 60 hours.

REQUESTED ACTION

The Champaign County Board approves the agreement by and between the Champaign County Board, Champaign County Sheriff and the Illinois F.O.P. Labor Council (Court Security Officers) for the term of January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019.

SAK Management Services, L.L.C. Agreement Term

As you are all aware, the County Board has entered into an agreement with SAK Management Services for management services at the Champaign County Nursing Home. The Agreement defines the Term as follows:

6.1 TERM The term of this Agreement shall commence on July 1, 2017 and shall continue until March 31, 2018 (Initial Term). After the expiration of the Initial Term, this Agreement shall automatically renew for successive two (2) month periods (each, a "Renewal Term"), unless either party notifies the other party in writing of its intention to terminate this Agreement at the end of the Initial Term, or any applicable Renewal Term, and such notice is given at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the Initial Term, or thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of any applicable Renewal Term.

If the County Board were to notify SAK of its intention to terminate the Agreement at the end of the Initial Term, that notification would be required by January 31, 2018.

At this time, it is our recommendation that the Term of the Agreement continue as written with an automatic renewal for a successive two month term to May 31, 2018, the first Renewal Term under the Agreement. If the County Board concurs with this recommendation, the following action is requested at the January 18, 2018 Board Meeting:

Motion to allow the Agreement with SAK Management Services, L.L.C. to automatically renew at the end of the Initial Term on March 31, 2018, for the first Renewal Term to continue through May 31, 2018.
