RE: Recommended Strategy to Close Out the Nursing Home Fund FY2018 Budget

Thank you for your consideration of the information and actions requested here. The County's management team dealing closely with these Nursing Home financial issues including Tami Ogden, Deputy Director of Finance; Van Anderson, Temporary Special Projects Administrator; Barbara Ramsay, Accounting Manager; and Deb Busey, Transition Administrator have all worked with me in developing the recommendations presented to you here. We all agree that the recommended actions to rectify these Nursing Home financial issues with the FY2018 budget is in the long term best interest of the County.

ISSUE 1 – ACCOUNTS PAYABLE:

The Nursing Home currently owes \$1,980,400 in outstanding Accounts Payable (AP) to its vendors with some amounts dating back to as old as FY2015. It is becoming increasingly complicated to the daily operation of the home to manage outstanding AP invoices.

RECOMMENDED STRATEGY TO ADDRESS ACCOUNTS PAYABLE CONCERNS:

Paying AP obligations now will provide significant relief to the daily operation and management of the Nursing Home business office and ancillary County accounting operations, as well as appropriately closing out the FY2018 budget with all outstanding obligations having been met at the end of the fiscal year. (The fiscal year ends December 31st and we have up to 60 days after the end date to reconcile all outstanding AP and AR issues.)

The \$1.98 million in outstanding AP should be resolved and paid from the FY2018 budget to ensure:

- The Home's vendors are made whole and continue to provide essential services some
 of which have been at risk in recent weeks because of the large amounts owed to certain
 vendors;
- Elimination of additional late fees and penalties being be paid by the County for some outstanding obligations;

- The Nursing Home Business Office and County's Auditor Office are not required to reenter hundreds of invoices and vouchers into the FY2019 Nursing Home and County
 accounting systems because they were not paid;
- The Nursing Home accounting is up-to-date and accurate in preparation for the real estate closing, minimizing problems that could otherwise occur at or after that closing.

Cash Flow - To ensure the General Corporate Fund does not encounter cash flow shortages prior to the Home's sale as a result of this transfer of funds; staff will begin preparation of a Promissory Note for the Board's consideration at its January Meeting. The Promissory Note of \$1,980,400 will allow the deposit of those funds back into the General Corporate Fund before a cash flow shortage that would otherwise occur in February or March. The Promissory Note can be structured so that it can be repaid sooner than 2 years, anticipating repayment will be made from the proceeds of the real estate sale and closing. The General Corporate Fund can be repaid the \$1,980,400 from the proceeds of the sale of the Nursing Home after the real estate closing.

ISSUE 2 – ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE:

The currently reported \$6,271,176.78 in Accounts Receivable for the Nursing Home does not accurately reflect collectible revenue. \$4,192,062.10 of this total is over 210 days old and due to that age should be considered uncollectable at this point.

RECOMMENDED STRATEGY FOR ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE CONCERNS:

An amount of \$4,192,062.10 should be written off as Bad Debt Expense to the FY2018 Budget. The act of writing off the expense does not preclude the County from still collecting on these obligations if it is able. However, the Budget Amendment accomplishes a more accurate reporting of outstanding AR and has been recommended to be documented in FY2018 by the County's outside auditor.

REQUESTED ACTION:

The County Board approves Budget Amendment 2018-00079 appropriating a transfer of \$1,980,400 from the General Corporate Fund to the Nursing Home Fund to allow the payment of all outstanding Accounts Payable through December 31, 2018 from the FY2018 Budget.

The County Board approves Budget Amendment 2018-00080 appropriating \$4,192,062.10 as Bad Debt Expense to the Nursing Home Fund in FY2018 in acknowledgement of the uncollectable status of outstanding Accounts Receivable that is over 210 days old.
