I have requested a budget amendment to cover the costs of temporary help to get work done when my Chief Deputy was on Family Medical Leave for three months.

Please note that the County Treasurer is responsible for investing county funds. However, the interest earned by the Treasurer goes to the individual funds, and is not reflected as revenue in the Treasurer's budget.

The attached chart shows that the \$567,009 in investment interest I earned for the County in 2019 for major funds exceeded budgeted interest by \$288,626.

In addition, I led the effort to secure a court order to get \$118,887.75 in unclaimed funds held by the State Treasurer by figuring out how to prove the money belonged to us.

These two efforts brought in a total of \$407,514 above-budget revenue.
