PARKING POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR THE COURTHOUSE COMPLEX

- 1. **<u>PURPOSE:</u>** The purpose of this policy is to:
- 1.1 Protect and promote the general health, safety, welfare, public convenience and good government of the County of Champaign by regulating parking at the Courthouse Complex.
- 1.2 Outline procedures for County staff in the implementation of the Champaign County Parking Policy.
- 1.3 Communicate to County Elected Officials, Department Heads, Employees and the Public, the formal County policy and procedures for parking at the Courthouse.
- 2. **<u>AUTHORITY:</u>** The Champaign County Physical Plant.
- 3. **<u>APPLICATION:</u>** This policy applies to all County Elected Officials, Department Heads, Employees and the general public.
- 4. **<u>RESPONSIBILITY</u>**: The Champaign County Physical Plant shall be responsible for the implementation of this policy.
- 5. **<u>DEFINITION(S)</u>**: NONE

6. <u>POLICY:</u>

- 6.1 <u>Creation of Parking:</u>
- 6.1.1. The Champaign County Physical Plant shall designate areas on County-owned/leased land to be used for parking vehicles and shall direct where County Elected Officials, Department Heads, Employees and the General Public shall park. Signage will be posted where appropriate to facilitate parking policy compliance. It is the intent of this policy to maximize the number of on-site parking spaces for the public use.
- 6.2 Designated Parking
 - 6.2.2 Parking is available at the following locations:
 - A) Off-site including Broadway (Sav-A-Lot) parking
 - B) Off-site Illini Oil Change Lot
 - C) Courthouse Lot F



- 7. **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES:** The Champaign County Physical Plant will authorize adjustments to the parking assignments. Parking is based on Seniority (Hire date with the County). Written appeals of adjustments may be made to the Champaign County Physical Plant Director. Decisions of the Director are final.
- 8. **DISCIPLINARY ACTION:** The Department Head shall have the authority to use progressive discipline for not adhering to this policy.
- 9. **ADMINISTRATOR/LEGAL COUNSEL REVIEW:** The Physical Plant Director has determined that this policy, as submitted to the Champaign County Facilities Committee, contains the necessary substance in order to carry out the purpose of the policy.







RE: Wilber Heights Neighborhood Improvements

Last summer, I responded to a resident of the Wilber Heights subdivision (east of Marketplace Mall) regarding the difficulties residents were having with road traffic, drainage of rainwater and enforcement of nuisance properties.

This edge-of-town neighborhood is in an industrial zoning classification and with proximity to the Interstate, the roadways and drainage have deteriorated with the growth of light industry traffic. Research showed that these issues have been persistent problems for several years (the County Planning & Zoning and Highways Departments did a significant study in 2013), with little resolution because, although located in unincorporated Champaign County, this neighborhood lies at the junction of several different jurisdictions that share boundaries and are only partially responsible for services in this 8-block area, to include the County, Somer Township, Beaver Creek and Saline Branch Drainage Districts, City of Champaign, Urbana-Champaign Sanitary District, Illinois Department of Transportation, Eastern Prairie Fire Protection District, CUMTD. Completion of the Olympic Drive connector in 2018 also adversely affected drainage to the north.

The solutions to remedy these issues are very costly, however Rep. Mike Marron and I have been able to negotiate an improvement plan that involves the reconstruction of Wilber Ave. by IDOT, followed by transfer of Wilber Ave. ownership from IDOT to Somer Township for future maintenance, and accompanied by repairs to the main conduit that drains water running under the railway tracks to the south of the subdivision. IDOT will pay for the Wilber Ave. reconstruction (\$990,000) and Representative Marron has contributed his member initiative funds of \$250,000 for this infrastructure improvement project, which will be managed through a grant from DCEO. The County Highway Department will provide engineering services to the project, estimated at \$50,000.

We are requesting the board to authorize acceptance of the \$250,000 DCEO grant and an accompanying budget amendment to appropriate the funds through the Highway Department.

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that based on the representations in the attached Petition, it is required pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501 to provide the requested aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Champaign County as follows:

1. The County Board hereby appropriates from the County Bridge Fund a sufficient sum to meet one-half the cost of <u>replacing</u> the structure.

2. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for said improvements.

3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, by receiving quotes for the improvements.

4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his or her approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvements and shall show the division of cost between the County and the <u>Harwood</u> Road District.

5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Harwood</u> Road District.

6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.





Subject:	Cannabis Revenue Confidentiality

The County started receiving County Cannabis Sales Tax revenues in October 2020. When the FY2021 Budget was prepared, it included this anticipated revenue in a separate budget line. The Illinois Department of Revenue recently distributed information regarding the confidentiality of Cannabis sales tax revenues. An excerpt from that communication is copied below.

Per statute, you may only share reasonable statistics concerning the operation of the tax by grouping the contents of returns so the information in any individual return is not disclosed (35 ILCS 120/11). The Department uses a rule of thumb that if there are fewer than 5 adult use cannabis dispensaries in your jurisdiction, even sharing the amount of allocations received from this tax is a breach of confidentiality.

Per 35 ILCS 120/11, a breach of confidentiality is subject to criminal punishment. Because Champaign County has fewer than five dispensaries, in consultation with the State's Attorney's Office, we will not disclose or separately record this revenue. In consultation with the Auditor's Office, we will include it in the One-cent Sales Tax revenue line, to be renamed Sales Tax, in order to safeguard the confidentiality of the information.
