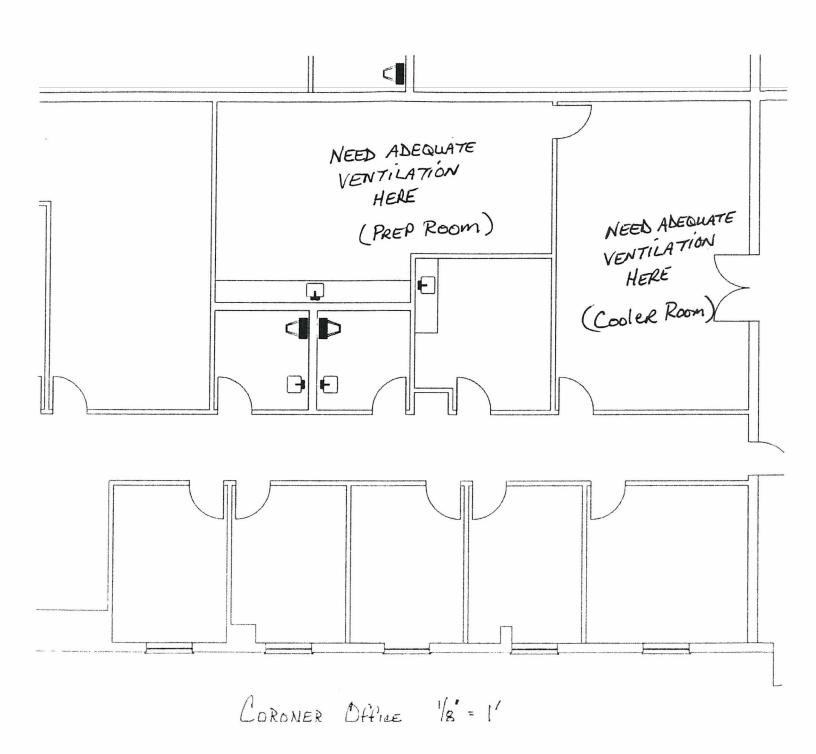
Dear Ms. Busey,

I am contacting you regarding the new coroner facility currently under construction here in Champaign County. Two issues have come up that must be addressed prior to completion of the construction project. The first issue concerns ventilation of the "Prep Room" and the "Cooler Room". Many death investigations conducted by the coroner's office involve victims of fire or extended time since death (decomposition). These circumstances produce extremely unpleasant odors generated by clothing, personal property, evidence, and decedents which are brought back to the coroner's office for processing, photographing, fingerprinting, identification, storage, etc... I had requested previously that a ventilation fan be installed in the "Prep Room" to remove these odors from the "Prep Room" and keep them from migrating to the office area. I was told it would be done however, I recently learned that the ventilation fan intended for this area is not adequate for removing the odors from this area. Therefore, I am requesting the board approve the changes necessary to upgrade the ventilation system to accomplish this purpose. I would also ask that, if possible, the ventilation system be connected to the "Cooler Room" for the same purpose as unpleasant odors will be present from evidence and property stored in this room as well.

Dear Ms. Busey,

I am contacting you regarding the new coroner facility currently under construction here in Champaign County. I have recently received notice from my forensic pathologist that he is willing to travel to Champaign County and perform autopsies in the new coroner facility. Champaign County currently utilizes facilities at the McLean County Coroner's Office in Bloomington, the Kankakee County Coroner's Office in Kankakee, and a facility in Springfield for autopsies. This adds considerable time and expense to each autopsy conducted by the Champaign County Coroner. We currently have a majority of the equipment needed to perform autopsies at the Champaign County Coroner's Office including a \$4500 autopsy table that has been collecting dust for several years. We are in need of an autopsy sink which could be installed with existing plumbing in the "Prep Room" of the new coroner facility allowing us to once again perform autopsies here in Champaign County. The cost of the new sink would be absorbed by the coroner's budget by utilizing the funds currently paid to McLean County to lease their facility for autopsies. I request the county Facilities Committee and the County Board consider approving the purchase and installation of an autopsy sink in the new coroner facility to increase efficiency and substantially reduce autopsy costs to Champaign County.

Dear Members of the Champaign County Board:

Recently, it has come to the attention of my department that Champaign County Coroner Duane Northrup is making arrangements to conduct autopsies in a new facility on East Main Street in Urbana. After consulting with my staff on this issue, the Urbana Police Department supports the concept of conducting autopsies locally.

The Urbana Police Department works alongside the Champaign County Coroner's Office on many death investigations. Not having to drive to McLean County to attend autopsies will save the Urbana Police Department both time and money. Financially speaking, two hours are needed to drive over and back, which is at a minimum accounted for by straight time and may be accounted for by overtime. Wear and tear on department vehicles and fuel costs are also considerations.

In addition to these financial issues, there is a convenience factor which cannot be understated. The Department will lose less time during death investigations due to the proximity of this facility. That time can be used to follow-up on other leads.

In conclusion, I simply would like to state that the Urbana Police Department would support autopsies being conducted locally.
