BACKGROUND

During 2010 and 2011, Champaign County, City of Urbana, City of Champaign, and Village of Savoy partnered to hold quarterly Countywide Residential Electronics Collections. The collections have been well received, with 291 tons of electronics collected during 2010 and 128 tons collected as of August this year. These quarterly drop-off collections have provided:

- areawide residents with convenient, one-stop opportunities to responsibly recycle electronics items; and
- opportunities to publicize the upcoming January 1, 2012 ban on TVs, computers, printers and monitors electronics items in Illinois landfills.

This summer, the State amended the Electronics Act (Public Act 97-0287) to ban additional electronics items from Illinois landfills beginning January 1, 2012.

Organizers from the local jurisdictions participating in these collections would like to continue the Countywide collections on a reduced schedule (from 4 to 2) during 2012. Additionally, organizers would like to allow for a 3rd Countywide collection to occur during 2012, but only if community response to a first collection appears sufficient to warrant a 3rd collection.

If the Countywide collections are approved to continue at a reduced schedule into 2012, organizers will use the collections as another means to provide information to the public regarding locally available options to recycle electronics items.

BUDGET/STAFFING IMPACT

Beginning in 2011, the recycling contractor assumed most of the costs involved holding the Countywide Residential Recycling Collections.

The County Recycling Coordinator staff time allocated for FY2012 is sufficient to accommodate 2 or 3 Countywide collections in 2012.

Contract Extension to Allow a Few Countywide Residential Electronics Collections to Occur in 2012

County Probation and Court Services staff are proponents of the County participating in 2, possibly 3, Countywide collections during 2012. For each collection that takes place, County Probation and Court Services typically provides 50 – 70 community service workers. Director Joe Gordon recently commented:

"This is the largest community service event the Court Services Department has ever participated in. It has met with great success as offenders come to appreciate the spirit of contributing to improving conditions within their own community. And those using the services very often favorably comment on the free service and on the efficiency of the event."

AMENDMENT

This Amendment is to the 'Agreement Regarding Provision of Recycling and/or Refurbishing Services for the 2010 and 2011 Countywide Residential Electronics Collection Events' entered into by the parties on May 4, 2010. Unless otherwise indicated in this Amendment, all provisions of that Agreement will remain in full force and effect.

This Amendment is made as of the date below the signature of the last entity to sign it, by and between THE NEWS-GAZETTE, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Host Site"), CHAMPAIGN COUNTY (hereinafter referred to as "Coordinator"), and VINTAGE TECH RECYCLERS, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

The parties agree the following amendments should be made to that Agreement:

Section 2, Item 2-2 The 2012 Countywide Residential Electronics Collections are scheduled to occur on:

- May 5, 2012 or May 19, 2012
- October 13, 2012 or October 20, 2012
- If event organizers and Coordinator schedule a third Collection event, that third Collection would be scheduled to occur on: August 4, 2012 or August 11, 2012 or August 18, 2012.

Section 5, Item 5-11 For each of the 2012 collection events, the Contractor agrees to waive all fees for the service of each Contractor employees sent by the Contractor works at the Host Site on a weekday immediately following or very soon after each collection event as described in Paragraph 5-10 above.

Section 5, Item 5-13 The Contractor agrees to pay the cost to lease the Host Site facility (The News Gazette Distribution Center) for each of the 2012 collection events at a rate of \$1,500 per collection event held.

Section 5, Item 5-15 The Host Site agrees to send an invoice the Contractor following each 2012 collection event to include the cost of leasing the Host Site, plus any services of Host Site employees or Host Site equipment utilized by the Contractor for each collection event.

Section 5, Item 5-16 The Contractor agrees to pay the cost of traffic control officer at a rate of \$50 per hour for service provided by the City of Champaign Police Department on the day of each 2012 collection event. The City of Champaign Police Department will send an invoice to the Contractor following each 2012 collection event. (*Typically 5 or 6 hours of traffic control service is provided on the day of each collection event.*)

AMENDMENT TO EXTEND THE LEASE FOR 2010 AND 2011 COUNTYWIDE RESIDENTIAL ELECTRONICS COLLECTION EVENTS

This Amendment is to the 'Lease for 2010 and 2011 Countywide Residential Electronics Collection Events' entered into by the parties on December, _____ 2011. Unless otherwise indicated in this Amendment, all provisions of that Agreement will remain in full force and effect.

This Amendment is made as of the date below the signature of the last entity to sign it, by and between THE NEWS-GAZETTE, INC. (hereinafter referred to as "Lessor"), the CITY OF URBANA, the CITY OF CHAMPAIGN, the VILLAGE OF SAVOY, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY (hereinafter referred to jointly as "Lessee"), and VINTAGE TECH RECYCLERS, LLC (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

The parties agree that the following amendments should be made to that Lease:

1. USE OF PREMISES

As an extension to the 2010 and 2011 Lease Agreement, the subject premises shall be used and occupied by Lessee as a station for the staging of two, possibly three, 2012 Countywide Residential Electronics Collection Events (hereinafter referred to as the "event" or "events") and for the temporary storage of electronics materials (e.g. computers, televisions, printers, etc.) accumulated during the events. The premises shall not be used for any other purpose.

The two events to be held during 2012 will occur on the following Saturday dates: May 5, 2012 or May 19, 2012 and October 13, 2012 or October 20, 2012.

If community response to the first 2012 event surpasses expectations of organizers, a third 2012 event may be scheduled to occur on: Saturday, August 4, 2012 or Saturday, August 11, 2012 or Saturday August 18, 2012.
