18 19	Weibel called the meeting to order at 4:38 p.m.		
20 21	ROLL CALL		
22 23 24	Goss, McGuire, Summers, and Weibel were present at the time of roll call, establishing the presence of a quorum.		
25 26	APPROVAL OF AGENDA/ADDENDUM		
27 28 29	MOTION by Goss to approve the agenda; seconded by Summers. Motion carried with unanimous support.		
30 31	APPROVAL OF MINUTES		
32 33 34	MOTION by Summers to approve the January 23, 2018 minutes; seconded by Goss. Motion carried with unanimous support.		
35 36	PUBLIC PARTICIPATION		
37 38	There was no public participation.		
39 40	DISCUSSION & APPROVAL OF NEW COUNTY BOARD RULES		
41 42 43 44 45 46 47 48	Weibel explained that the discussion and approval of the new County Board Rules would be an on-going item on every agenda, as the committee members worked through each section to the ultimate final draft. The committee discussed current committee structure pros and cons. Suggested changes for consideration: 1) all standing committees 2) an additional Committee of the Whole meeting incorporating the current standing committees of Environment & Land Use; Facilities; and Highway & Transportation. Busey pointed out that at one time there had been a second Committee of the Whole and it was very effective.		

49 Other suggestions were to make Justice & Social Services a standing committee; move Facilities 50 to the Committee of the Whole with Finance and Policy. 51 52 Busey believed that the Committee of the Whole with Finance and Policy is very valuable because 53 it is at this meeting where issues are flushed out and discussed with all the board members present. Then 54 there is time between the Committee of the Whole meeting and the County Board meeting for resolution 55 of issues. 56 57 The committee also discussed possible changes to the titles of the County Board Chair, Vice-58 Chair and Caucus Chairs. There was no objection to the continued use of these titles. 59 60 The committee agreed that it was important for the County Executive to designate an individual who would preside over meetings if he/she is unavailable. The committee discussed whether this 61 62 individual should be a county board member and if so, would this county board member essentially vote 63 twice in the event of a tie; once as a county board member, then again to break a tie vote. 64 65 Committee members would discuss the suggested changes to committee structure with their 66 respective caucuses and report back at the next meeting. Busey encouraged inclusion of the County Executive in the preparation of agendas; clarifying in the rules that it is ultimately up to the County Board 67 68 Chair. 69 70 Weibel would summarize the changes discussed for the next meeting. He encouraged committee 71 members to review the Will County Board Rules and Procedures for changes and modifications necessary 72 to the Champaign County Board Rules. 73 74 The next meeting is Tuesday, February 20, 2018 at 4:30 p.m. 75 76 **QUESTIONS FOR ST.
