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1 Mr. Rooney answered he would be at the full board meeting. 2 3 Ms. Wysocki stated when she attended the caucus there were some questions asked about where 4 the enterprise zone is, what are the benefits of having an enterprise zone and is there a 5 downside to having an enterprise zone. 6 7 Mr. Rooney stated that he is the County Board Enterprise Zone Administrator. Mr. Rooney said the 8 amendment proposed a100% abatement if at least twenty jobs are retained and this will make the county 9 more competitive with other communities. Mr. Rooney said right now, we have about 50% abatement on 10 sales tax and property tax. We are asking for 100% abatement. Mr. Rooney said it is easier to retain a 11 company than to try to bring in a new company in a community. Mr. Rooney said this is an economic 12 development incentive that we're asking the County Board to approve. He also explained that the purpose 13 for this incentive is to encourage existing companies in the community to grow. 14 15 Craig Rost, Deputy City Manager for Development for the City of Champaign stated that often times a 16 company will relocate rather than expand which means job erosion in the community. With this incentive 17 we hope to retain these jobs. Mr. Rost went on to say that about 70% of our job growth comes from business 18 expansion. He also explained that the incentive we presently have is 50% on building material sales tax and 19 property tax and increasing the incentive to 100% will make us more competitive with other communities. 20 21 Mr. Rost said that most of the enterprise zone businesses are located in the City of Champaign however 22 there was one that was outside the city. 23 24 Mr. Rooney said we had approved the expansion on the enterprise zone on Staley Road. so some things will 25 affect the county. 26 27 Mr. Langeheim asked if there was less incentive for companies with less than 20 employees. 28 29 Mr. Rost answered for less than 20 employees the incentive will be 50%. 30 31 5. **Other Business** 32 33 None 34 35 16.
