Re: Rantoul Municipal Landfill Permit Application

Dear Ms. Rietz:

Please find attached the public notice of a permit application (LPC-PA16) for the proposed modifications to the Rantoul Municipal Landfill. The proposed landfill cap improvements to this closed landfill are to alleviate an area on the landfill cover that ponds a small amount of stormwater resulting from rainfall events.

Briefly, the project consists of placing a geosynthetic clay liner (GCL) in the ponding area, placing clean soil on top of the GCL, and grading the immediate general area to facilitate positive surface drainage from the cap. In identified areas, rip rap will be added to assist in dissipating water energy.

Construction is anticipated to begin September 2016 with construction completion occurring prior to winter snow melt and spring rain events. This schedule will help mitigate any further potential stormwater seepage into the landfill.
