Call to Order

Chair Cowart called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A roll call confirmed a quorum present.

Approval of Agenda/Addendum

MOTION by Knott to approve the agenda; seconded by Carter. There was no addendum for the meeting. **Motion Carried.**

Approval of Minutes

MOTION by Knott to approve the minutes of May 9, 2008 as presented; seconded by Jay. **Motion carried.**

Public Participation

There was no public participation.

Monthly Reports

County & Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims - May 2008

MOTION by Jay to receive and place on the file the County & Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims for May 2008; seconded by Carter.

Mr. O'Connor asked if this was the first and only bill for the City of Champaign Engineering Fees. Mr. Blue explained this is just the beginning.

Motion carried.

<u>County Engineer</u> Curtis Road Agreement – Amendment #3

Mr. Blue explained this is an Intergovernmental Agreement for the utility relocation on the next section of Curtis Road, which is to be built in 2009 from Wynstone Drive to Wesley. Utility relocation will be done this summer and after they have a handle on the right of way, when they go to bid in January of 2009 and the contractors start spring of 2009, all the utility adjustments will be out of the way. The County signed an agreement years ago with 50% cost share of utility relocation, engineering fees, right of way and construction. They have already done the engineering and right of way agreements and the total cost for the relocation of the utilities is estimated to be \$559,000, this includes relocating power lines, phone lines and the U of I gas main. The County's portion of that is \$279,500, which is laid out in the agreement. He explained they have been working with Dennis Schmidt about how we are going to pay for this and it looks like we will be able to push payments for Curtis Road out through about 2012.

MOTION by Jay to recommend County Board approval of Amendment #3; seconded by O'Connor.

Mr. Weibel asked if the cost for this was anticipated. Mr. Blue explained these costs were in the original cost estimate. When asked about the U of I gas line, Mr. Blue explained the U of I has only a few opportunities to shut down and switch over and one of them is March and one is October. We do not have the power to make the U of I pay for this themselves; they were there first and have the authority to ask us to pay for the move. They will also abandon the old line in place because it is expensive to pull out.

Motion carried.

Resolution for Award Authority - Pavement Striping Bids

Mr. Blue explained they have their letting, where they stripe all 200 miles of the county roads, on June 16. There is a 10 day wait before awarding so he is asking to be given the authority to award to the lowest responsible bidder, as long as the bids are within 10% of the estimate.

MOTION by Jay to recommend County Board approval of the Resolution for Award Authority; seconded by Bensyl.

Motion carried.

Major Bridge Award

Mr. Blue stated that there is a program through IDOT where you can apply for funding when there is a bridge over a million dollars. There is a bridge on County Road 16 with an estimated cost of \$1,450,000. In December 2007 he applied for a grant to construct that project and it is has been awarded and in 2013 we will be receiving \$1,160,000 to build that bridge.

Building Update - Open House

Mr. Blue explained they have been moving the entire week. The maintenance area is 80% moved to the new building and as of this afternoon the office will be 95% moved over. They will switch over the phones and start operating out of that building as of Monday. He reminded the committee there is an open house planned on July 12th.

Mr. Weibel stated he, Ms. Cowart and Mr. Langenheim will be at the NACO Conference on the 12th. Mr. Blue stated they can move the date to the 19th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

MOTION by Knott to enter into Closed Session pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2 (c) (5) to discuss the purchase or lease of real property for the use of Champaign County; seconded by Jay. **Motion carried** with a 6/0 roll call vote. Voting yes was Cowart, Bensyl, Carter, Jay, Knott and O'Connor.

AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THIS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Chapter 605 ILCS 5/5-503 provided that any bridge, culvert or drainage structure located on a County Highway on the Champaign County Line, or deviating therefrom within 80 rods, with a waterway opening in excess of 25 square feet shall be constructed and repaired by such counties and the expense of such construction and repair shall be born in a proportion to the assessed valuation of the taxable property in the respective counties in the last preceding equalized assessment, or on such other just and equitable basis as the parties may agree, and

WHEREAS, there is a bridge, IDOT Structure #010-4232 located between Sections 4 & 9 in Ayers Township on the Champaign-Vermilion County Line that meets the above requirements, and

WHEREAS, this structure is in need of replacement, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of replacement of the aforesaid bridge, including construction and design engineering, is estimated to be \$260,200.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chair of the County Board of Champaign County is hereby authorized to sign the aforementioned Intergovernmental Agreement to provide for the replacement of IDOT Structure #010-4232, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Board of Champaign County will appropriate One Hundred Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$107,700.00) from the County Bridge Fund to meet its agreed share of the reasonable cost of replacement of said bridge, as set forth in the Intergovernmental Agreement, including approaches and construction and design engineering, and that the County Board direct the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared and contracts to be let by and through the appropriate Committee, subject to approval by the County Board, and

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between Vermilion County of the State of Illinois, hereinafter referred to as VERMILION COUNTY and Champaign County of the State of Illinois, hereafter referred to as CHAMPAIGN COUNTY.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties hereto, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and insure safety to the motoring public, are desirous of reconstructing a deficient bridge, VERMILION COUNTY Structure Number 092-3025, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY Structure Number 010-4232 on the Champaign-Vermilion County Line approximately 2.0 miles north of Allerton Illinois. The improvement is to be known as VERMILION COUNTY Section 08-17124-00-BR and CHAMPAIGN COUNTY Section 08-00949-00-BR and referred to as the PROJECT. The new Structure Number is to be 010-4547.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. VERMILION COUNTY agrees to provide for surveys, the preparation of the plans specifications and estimate at its expense subject to partial reimbursement from CHAMPAIGN COUNTY.
- 2. VERMILION COUNTY agrees to acquire any additional right of way necessary for the PROJECT at its expense.
- CHAMPAIGN COUNTY agrees to participate in construction costs of the PROJECT in direct proportion to the most recent equalized assessed valuation for the two counties.
- 4. CHAMPAIGN COUNTY agrees to let & award a contract, provide engineering supervision during construction and cause the PROJECT to be constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimate.
- 5. Ayers Road District in CHAMPAIGN COUNTY will retain maintenance and jurisdiction of the completed improvement.
- 6. CHAMPAIGN COUNTY agrees to pay the contractor and request reimbursement from VERMILION COUNTY in accordance with the division of cost.
- 7. It is mutually agreed the estimated Division of Cost is as follows:

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PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

PETITION

Petitioner, <u>Marvin Johnson</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the <u>Compromise</u> Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a culvert located <u>between Sections 19 & 30</u>, which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be replaced; and
- 4. The cost of <u>replacing</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$5,600.00, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Compromise</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Compromise</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
