PETITION

Petitioner, <u>Greg Frerichs</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- l. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the <u>Ogden</u> Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>culvert</u> located <u>between Sections 7 & 7</u>, which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be replaced; and
- 4. The cost of <u>replacing</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$22,000.00, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Ogden</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Ogden</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The <u>Ogden</u> Road District is prepared to pay one-half of the cost of the <u>replacement</u> of said structure.

RESOLUTION NO.

PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that based on the representations in the attached Petition, it required pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501 to provide the requested aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Champaign County as follows:

- 1. The County Board hereby appropriates from the County Bridge Fund a sufficient sum to meet one-half the cost of <u>replacing</u> the structure on the aforesaid petition to cover the cost of materials.
- 2. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for said improvement.
- 3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, either by the letting of a contract or by the County Highway Department doing the work.
- 4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his or her approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvement, and shall show the division of cost between the County and the Ogden Road District.
- 5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Ogden</u> Road District.
 - 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

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

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


Ogden Township Location Map



ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERED SPEED ZONE ON COUNTY HIGHWAY 50 (LAKE OF THE WOODS ROAD)

WHEREAS, It is hereby declared by the County Board of Champaign County, Illinois, that due to the 35 miles per hour design speed of bridge 010-0289 carrying County Highway 50 over Interstate 74 the basic statutory vehicular speed limit established by Section 11-604 of the Illinois Vehicle Code is greater than that considered reasonable and proper on County Highway 50 (Lake of the Woods Road) from US Route 150 northeast to County Highway 54 (Tin Cup Road), a distance of 1.0 mile, for which Champaign County has maintenance responsibility and which is not under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT DECLARED, That by virtue of Section 11-604 of the above Code, and in accordance with the design speed of structure 010-0289 it was determined that the reasonable and proper absolute maximum speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour; and

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED, That this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of said signs giving notice of the maximum speed limit.
