Call to Order Committee Chair Cowart called the meeting to order at 9:08 a.m. II. Roll Call A verbal roll call was taken and a quorum was declared present. III. Approval of Agenda/Addendum **MOTION** by Mr. Rosales to approve the agenda; seconded by Mr. Stohr. Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED unanimously. IV. Approval of Minutes – January 4, 2019 MOTION by Mr. Clifford to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2019 meeting; seconded by Mr. Rosales. Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED unanimously. V. Public Participation None VI. Communications Mr. Rosales stated he attended the funeral of former County Board Member, Linda Cross. VII. County & Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims – January 2019 MOTION by Mr. Rosales to receive and place on file the County and Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims for January 2019; seconded by Mr. Stohr. Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED unanimously. VIII. 2018 Final Bridge Report Mr. Blue discussed the 2018 Final Bridge Report. He stated that when resolutions are passed for bridge projects, we are required to report the final cost after completion. The first page of the report listed four large bridges that were completed in 2018. The second page outlined the total cost for various

 culvert projects completed in 2018. The report was for information only.
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IX. Resolution Authorizing Execution of a Transfer of Legal Representation Agreement and Engagement Letter 52 Mr. Blue stated attorney Sheryl Churney has represented Champaign County regarding the California 53 Ridge Wind Farm. The County has paid no fees for her services. All fees have been billed to California 54 Ridge. Effective January 1, 2019, Sheryl Churney will be employed as an attorney with the law firm of 55 Klein, Thorpe & Jenkins, Ltd. Mr. Blue explained that for Sheryl Churney to continue to represent 56 Champaign County in connection with the wind farm road use agreement a resolution authorizing the 57 transfer of legal representation must be completed. Mr. Stohr asked about the cost of copying per 58 page. Mr. Blue said he would find out the cost for copying per page before the next board meeting. 59 **MOTION** by Mr. Stohr to approve the resolution; seconded by Mr. Clifford. Upon vote, the **MOTION CARRIED unanimously**. 60

62 X. Transportation Funding Discussion

63 Mr. Blue informed the committee on January 24, 2019 he met with Illinois representatives from 64 Champaign County and twenty Highway Commissioners regarding transportation funding. Mr. Blue 65 discussed the 2019 transportation needs throughout the state of Illinois. Mr. Blue discussed the handouts explaining the Motor Fuel Tax formula and how the money flows. Mr. Blue said we need the 66 67 funding to be sustainable and long lasting. The current formula works well and is a good way to distribute funds. Mr. Blue discussed the 2017 MFT distributions for the County and townships. He said 68 69 the problem is that MFT funds have not increased in almost 30 years however, the expense for bridge 70 projects and the price of asphalt have almost tripled. Mr. Stohr asked about the recent report on the 71 pavement condition index. Mr. Blue said the pavement condition measures the top of the roadways. He 72 said the PCI does not address safety issues. Many roadways have narrow pavement and narrow 73 shoulders. Mr. Blue asked the committee to consider attending the 2019 Transportation Lobby Day on 74 Wednesday, April 3rd in Springfield. Lobby Day attendees will visit with state legislators to discuss the importance of transportation funding. 75

Mr. Blue informed the committee that Josh Reifsteck was promoted to the Road Foreman position.

PETITION

Petitioner, <u>Ronald Scudder</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the <u>Condit</u> Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and

2. There is a <u>culvert</u> located <u>between Sections 5 & 6</u>, which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and

3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be <u>replaced</u>; and

4. The cost of <u>replacing</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$4,500.00, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Condit</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and

5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Condit</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and

6. The <u>Condit</u> Road District is prepared to pay one-half of the cost of the <u>replacement</u> of said structure.

RESOLUTION NO.

PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

WHEREAS, the County Board finds that based on the representations in the attached Petition, it required pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501 to provide the requested aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Champaign County as follows:

1. The County Board hereby appropriates from the County Bridge Fund a sufficient sum to meet one-half the cost of <u>replacing</u> the structure.

2. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for said improvements.

3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, by receiving quotes for the improvements.

4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his or her approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvements, and shall show the division of cost between the County and the <u>Condit</u> Road District.

5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Condit</u> Road District.

6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
