- I. Call to Order Committee Chair Cowart called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

VIII. FY 20 Bridge Report

Mr. Blue reviewed the Final Bridge Report discussing the breakdown of costs for each project that was completed in 2020.

IX. CH 13 Section #19-00077-00-BR Bridge Letting Results

Mr. Blue discussed the bridge letting results for County Highway 13. He stated that four bids were received with Big O Services submitting the lowest bid. Big O Services submitted a bid amount of \$524,854.70 only 2 percent over the engineer's estimate. In January of this year a resolution was passed allowing Mr. Blue to accept the low bid for construction if the low bid was within 10% of the engineer's estimate.

X. Petition Requesting and Resolution Approving Appropriation of Funds from the County Bridge Fund, Harwood Township #21-11108-00-BR

Mr. Blue discussed a culvert in Harwood Township that is in poor condition and needs replaced. The culvert is north of 136 and east of Rantoul. The estimated cost of replacing the culvert is \$20,000.00.

XI. Petition Requesting and Resolution Approving Appropriation of Funds from the County Bridge Fund, Sadorus Township #21-22106-00-BR

Mr. Blue discussed a bridge in Sadorus Township that needs repaired. The bridge is located between sections 23 & 26. The estimated cost of repairing the bridge is \$18,000.00. **MOTION** by Mr. Passalacqua to approve the resolution; seconded by Mr. McGuire. **MOTION CARRIED by unanimous roll-call vote.** Yeas: Ammons, McGuire, Passalacqua, Raab, Straub, Michaels, Cowart -7 Nays: None

XII. Petition Requesting and Resolution Approving Appropriation of Funds from the County Bridge Fund, Sadorus Township #21-22107-00-BR
 Mr. Blue informed the committee there is another bridge also located in Sadorus Township that needs repaired. The bridge is located between sections 11 & 15. The cost of repairing the bridge is estimated to be \$17,000.00.

 - The review of the Closed Session Minutes is scheduled for the March 2021 Agenda.

Mr. Summers asked about the damaged bridge over interstate 74. Mr. Blue said the bridge is on a township road in Saint Joseph Township. The Illinois Department of Transportation has secured the bridge and placed detour signs. The damaged bridge is part of IDOT's 5-year Capital Improvement Plan. The closing should have no impact on Champaign County Highway.

Mr. Summers asked for an explanation of riprap. Mr. Blue explained this is large rocks that are placed under the bridge to stop erosion. The rip rap is usually placed 2-3' thick and then grout is placed overt he rocks.

Mr. Blue informed the committee he supports the decision to offer County employees weekly COVID Testing through the University of Illinois testing site.
