# VIII. FY 2022 Section 5311 Rural Public Transportation and Downstate Operating Assistance Program (DOAP) Applications for Champaign County Area Rural Transit System (C-CARTS)

Samuel Stewart, CCRPC/Program Compliance Oversight Monitor provided information for the Champaign County Area Rural Transit System (C-CARTS). Mr. Stewart said for Champaign County to continue to receive rural public transportation operating funding they are required to submit grant applications annually for Section 5311 (Rural Public Transportation) and Illinois Downstate Operating Assistance Program (DOAP). The grants are awarded annually based on the Illinois Department of Transportation's fiscal year (July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022). The resolution for Acceptance of Special Warranty is also required as part of the Federal and State grant applications. The total federal and state request for FY 2022 is \$877,723, which is the same amount requested in FY 2021. The committee requested the Special Warranty attachment be included with the documents for the consent agenda.

#### IX. Applied Research Associates, Inc.-Pavement Management System Update 2021-2025

Bill Vavrik, Vice President and Principal Engineer with Applied Research Associates, Inc. (ARA) provided information on the Champaign County Highway Department's pavement management system (PMS). Mr. Vavrik stated that ARA manages the PMS through a multiyear contract with the County. The PMS is used to evaluate, assess, and mange approximately 400 lane-miles of County maintained roads in Champaign County. The goal is to keep roads in as good as condition as we can with limited resources. The long-life treatment strategy, using the right treatment, on the right road, at the right time. The overall condition of the roads has increased steadily since 2006. Preventive maintenance extends the life of the road. Mr. Summers asked about the use of hot in place recycling in Champaign County. Mr. Blue discussed several roads where hot in place recycling has been used.

## X. Resolution Appropriating an Additional \$250,000 from County Bridge Funds for the Replacement of Structure #010-0224, CH 13 Section #19-00077-00-BR

Mr. Blue informed the committee that additional funds were needed for the bridge replacement on County Highway 13. The estimate was originally for the replacement of a triple box culvert however a bridge replacement is needed. In February 2020, \$400,000 was previously appropriated. The updated cost of replacing the bridge including preliminary engineering is now estimated to be \$650,000.

# PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

#### **PETITION**

Petitioner, <u>Rick Wolken</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the <u>Somer Road</u> District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>culvert</u> located <u>between Sections 28 & 29</u>, which is in poor condition and is inadequate to serve the needs of the traveling public; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be <u>replaced</u>; and
- 4. The cost of <u>replacing</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be <u>\$32,800.00</u>, which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Somer</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Somer</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The <u>Somer Road</u> District is prepared to pay one-half of the cost of the <u>replacement</u> of said structure.


WHEREAS, the County Board finds that based on the representations in the attached Petition, it is required pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501 to provide the requested aid.

- 5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Somer</u> Road District.

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# PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

#### **PETITION**

Petitioner, <u>Steve Miller</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>Bridge</u> located on County Road 250N between Sections 19 and 20 in <u>Pesotum</u> Township, over the Two Mile Slough, which is in poor condition; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said bridge be replaced; and
- 4. The cost to <u>replace</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$400,000 which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The <u>Pesotum</u> Road District is prepared to pay 10% of the construction cost and 50% of the engineering costs associated with the replacement of said structure.

- 5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District.
  - 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.


