A. County & Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims February 2025

**MOTION** by Carter to receive and place on file the County and Township Motor Fuel Tax Claims for February 2025; seconded by Sullard.

Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

B. FY 2026 Section 5311 Rural Public Transportation and Downstate Operating Assistance Program (DOAP) Applications for Champaign County Area Rural Transit System (C-CARTS)

 Emma Woods, CCRPC/Program Compliance Oversight Monitor, presented information for the annual grant applications for C-CARTS. Woods discussed background information, current projects, vehicle inventory, and possible service opportunities. She stated to continue to receive rural public transportation funding, Champaign County is required annually to submit grant applications for FTA section 5311 (Rural Public Transportation) and IL Downstate Operating Assistance Program (DOAP). The grants are awarded based on the Illinois Department of Transportation's Fiscal Year (July 1, 2025-June30, 2026

- 1. Resolution Authorizing Execution and Amendment of Section 5311 Grant Agreement
- 2. Public Transportation Ordinance
- 3. Acceptance of Special Warranty
- 4. Resolution Authorizing Execution and Amendment of Downstate Operating Assistance Agreement

C. Resolution Authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement for Participation in the Illinois Public Works Mutual Aid Network (IPWMAN)

D. Intergovernmental Agreement Providing for Membership in the Illinois Public Works Mutual Aid Network Agreement

Blue discussed Champaign County's participation in the Illinois Public Works Mutual Aid Network. He said the State's Attorney's office has reviewed and approved the Intergovernmental Agreement and the Resolution.

**MOTION** by Peugh to approve the Resolution Authorizing an Intergovernmental Agreement for Participation in the Illinois Public Works Mutual Aid Network (IPWMAN); seconded by Carter. Upon vote, the **MOTION CARRIED unanimously.** 

E. Highway Department Budget Review FY 2025

Blue provided an overview of each of the Highway Department Funds explaining the major expense categories. The County Highway Fund 2083 is primarily used as the operations fund. This includes personnel, commodities, utilities, and equipment. He explained that each year funds are transferred to the Highway Building Capital Fund 062. The funds accumulate until large building

repairs are necessary. The County Bridge Fund 2084 is used to build bridges. The fund was set up in statute for counties to use the Bridge Funds to help townships build their bridges. If township needs are met, then available funds are used on county bridges. The Motor Fuel Tax Fund is from the State of Illinois gas tax. The funds are used for the County Engineer's salary and for road and bridge maintenance and improvements. The townships receive separate Motor Fuel Tax Funds. The Highway Federal Aid Matching Fund is used to match federal projects that require local matching funds. The IDOT Rebuild Grant Funds have all been expended.

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#### F. Bridge Report FY 2023-2024

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Blue discussed the bridge projects that were closed out in fiscal years 2023 and 2024. Champaign County Highway Resolutions state that the Highway Department will report back to the County Board and Townships the total funds spent on each bridge project.

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**MOTION** by Sullard to receive and place on file the Bridge Report for fiscal year 2023-2024; seconded by Peugh.

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Upon vote, the MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

# PETITION REQUESTING AND RESOLUTION APPROVING APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COUNTY BRIDGE FUND PURSUANT TO 605 ILCS 5/5-501

#### **PETITION**

Petitioner, <u>Robert Sherman</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the Hensley Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>Bridge</u> located on North Rising Road (700 E) between Sections 29 and 30 in Hensley Township, which is in poor condition; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said bridge be replaced; and
- 4. The cost to <u>replace</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$300,000 which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Hensley</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Hensley</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The <u>Hensley</u> Road District is prepared to pay 50% of the local cost associated with the replacement of said structure.

- 2. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to cause plans and specifications to be prepared for said improvement.
- 3. The County Board hereby orders that said improvement be made under the general supervision of the County Engineer, by receiving bids for the improvements.
- 4. The County Board hereby directs the County Engineer to certify to the County Board when the work has been satisfactorily completed to meet his approval. Such certificate shall include an itemized account of the cost of all items of work incurred in the completion of said improvement and shall show the division of cost between the County and the Hensley Road District.
- 5. The County Board further directs the County Engineer to file said certificate with the clerk of the <u>Hensley</u> Road District.
  - 6. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.

Petitioner, <u>Josh Eisenmenger</u>, hereby requests an appropriation of funds from the Champaign County Bridge Fund pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/5-501. In support of this petition, Petitioner states the following:

- 1. Petitioner is the duly elected Highway Commissioner for the Pesotum Road District, Champaign County, Illinois; and
- 2. There is a <u>structure</u> located on 700 E between Sections 5 and 6 in Pesotum Township, which is in poor condition; and
- 3. To ensure the adequacy of said structure for the traveling public, it is necessary that said structure be replaced; and
- 4. The cost to <u>replace</u> the aforesaid structure is estimated to be \$50,000 which will be more than .02% of the value of all the taxable property in the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue; and
- 5. The tax rate for road purposes in the <u>Pesotum</u> Road District was in each year for the last two (2) years not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Section 6-501 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-501); and
- 6. The <u>Pesotum</u> Road District is prepared to pay 50% of the cost associated with the replacement of said structure.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Champaign County as follows:
