## V. <u>Public Participation</u>

She stated that inflation is up 9% and sited a Bloomberg Economics article stating Americans will spend an additional \$5,200 this year. Using the typical raise that is given each year, she gave some figures to show how that raise will not cover the additional costs this year and explained that many employees are forced to work two or three jobs to make ends meet.

Laura Clark, Circuit Clerk employee and AFSCME Treasurer, has worked for the County for four and a half years. She explained how she has had to take on a second job and what her typical week looks like, working about fourteen hours a day. She explained how her job is important to keep the County running and requested the Committee show that they value the employees' labor.
