Mr. Quisenberry would like to present the revised Strategic Plan Values, Vision and Mission to the County Board Committee of the Whole (COW) Policy Committee on 8/12/14 for feedback. The County Board will discuss Strategic Planning goals at their September COW meeting.

Ms. Petrie suggested a clarification under *Quality of Life* that should read, "Effectively manage real estate tax system cycle". The Committee agreed.

The Committee agreed to change the listed order of the Values to:
Diversity
Teamwork
Responsibility to the Public
Justice
Quality of Life

Mr. Quisenberry thought the comments from the last update in 2011 were very informative. Ms. Petrie would like to use the same format to solicit fresh ideas and initiatives. Criteria must be established to determine if an initiative has enough support to be included in the strategic plan. All ideas should be included in the matrix and shared with the public and County Board members. A study session in October could be an opportunity for Board members to lobby their initiatives and then rank them at the end of the session.

The next Strategic Planning Committee meeting will be on 9/2/14 or 9/4/14 depending on the date that most members can attend. The meeting will discuss County Board feedback on Values, Vision and Mission. The Strategic Planning Committee will strategize on goals to be brought to the COW in September.
