I. Welcome and Introductions

Chairman John Dwyer called the meeting to order at 10:30 am and introductions were made.

II. Public Comment

No public comments offered.

III. Review and approval of minutes from the February 28th, 2017 meeting

Deb Goettig made the motion for approval and Bill James seconded and all approved.

- IV. Follow-up on Commodity Flow Study-the first portion involving the use of pole-mounted cameras to record CN rail traffic was completed and the RPC is analyzing the data. The second portion of the study is schedule for the fall along the same line to get a seasonal understanding of the traffic.
- V. Tier II Facility Reporting Lori Canterbury
 Companies are being required to file GHS SDS with their Tier 2 filings. Between now and 1 March
 2018 companies have been instructed to make these corrections. The report due by 1 March 2018
 for reporting year 2017, this submission will be mandatory.
- VI. Midwest Conference:

Three significant take-aways: 1) exercises must be based on observable actions, a) personnel must be trained to properly evaluate and b) improvement items must be recorded and assigned a date and

person/agency to get corrected. 2) New free software for pc, android and OS include the 2016 ERG book and the Cameo chemicals database-worthwhile additions. 3) West Texas Fertilizer Plant—permitting the status quo is dangerous; a proactive approach to timely inspection and knowledge of facilities is required. When land use changes-if found to be incompatible with the existing environment this must be challenged

VII. Marathon Pipeline

Presentation from the Marathon Pipeline on the pipeline system, monitoring processes, products transported and preventative measures taken to keep the line safe. Information provided as to the identification of problems and appropriate response.

VIII. Local incidents, training, exercises and upcoming events discussion

It was noted that all 2017 incidents to-date have been minor, primarily involving spilled diesel fuel..

Champaign Fire brought the Decon Trailer to the Pioneer St joe facility to brief supervisors on the process should the need arise.
