July has been active with tabletop exercises on the Surge Facility Activation, the Biological Detection System at the US Post Office, and the distribution of the National Pharmaceutical Stock Pile. The Surge Facility exercise showed we needed to change how we were to triage patients and the time allowed for activation of the facility. The Post Office went very well with only one change in the plan on where we placed employees after decontamination. The pharmaceutical distribution exercise showed that the Illinois Department of Public Health had changed their plan on distributing to the County level and will require us to adjust our plan.

We worked the Command Post for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July activities as a Unified Command Post. We assisted the Sheriffs with a search, and worked with McKinley Health Center on their Emergency Plan.

I attended the Illinois Emergency Management training on Damage Assessment. FEMA has changed the forms used in assessing damage after a disaster and the reporting system.

We continue to work on our Special Needs Assessment project as to locating special needs population and how we may warn and care for these individuals in case of an evacuation.
