The Veterans Assistance Commission program continues to stay busy.

Funds Assist – The largest month in program history. Budget is at 72% through ten months.

Phone Calls – Returned to normal.

Office Visits – Increased from an average of 24 per month to 54 in August. Increase due to WCIA segment and veterans seeking info on government shutdown.

Recertification training held September 9-13 in Bloomington VAC is recertified for 2014.

Even though the veterans do not have to tell the VAC, if their VA claims were granted. Two veterans notified the office that they were now receiving \$1503.00 and \$395.00 monthly. To date, that is over \$5000.00 per month that veterans are receiving in federal VA compensation payments.
