

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CHAMPAIGN,
ILLINOIS AND SANGAMON VALLEY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT REGARDING THE USE OF
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDING FOR FIRST RESPONDER EQUIPMENT

This Amendment No. 1 (“Amendment”) is entered into by and between the County of Champaign, Illinois (“County”) and the Sangamon Valley Fire Protection District (“SVFPD”), collectively referred to as the “Parties.”

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into an Agreement regarding the use of opioid settlement funding for first responder equipment, effective on the date of the last signature thereto (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provided opioid settlement funding in the amount of \$29,727.86 for the purchase of a cardiac monitor device; and

WHEREAS, SVFPD has identified an opportunity to purchase additional eligible equipment from the approved vendor at a discounted price; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to authorize the use of any remaining unexpended funds from the original award for such additional equipment without increasing the total amount of funding provided under the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 3, Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Agreement are amended to permit SVFPD to utilize any remaining unexpended funds from the original award amount of \$29,727.86 for the purchase of additional medical first responder equipment from the same vendor, provide that:
 - a. The total amount expended shall not exceed the original award amount of \$29,727.86;
 - b. The equipment purchased is related to and supports emergency medical response services serving opioid-impacted individuals and communities;
 - c. All purchases remain subject to the terms, conditions, reporting requirements, and allowable uses set forth in the Agreement; and
 - d. Documentation of all purchases shall be maintained and provided to the County upon request.
2. No Additional Funding – This Amendment does not increase the amount of funding awarded under the Agreement. SVFPD shall not be entitled to reimbursement beyond the original award amount of \$29,727.86.

3. Ratification – Except as expressly modified by this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and affirmed.
